

VMware Tanzu Platform Specific Program Documentation (“SPD”)

The Broadcom software program(s) (“Broadcom Software” or “Software”) listed below is provided under the following terms and conditions in addition to any terms and conditions referenced on the Broadcom quote, order form, statement of work, or other mutually agreed ordering document (each a “Transaction Document”) under the applicable end user agreement or governing contract (collectively, the “Agreement”) entered into by Customer and the Broadcom entity (“Broadcom”) through which Customer obtained a license for the Broadcom Software. These terms shall be effective from the effective date of such Transaction Document. Capitalized terms have the meanings ascribed to them herein, or, otherwise, in the Agreement (including the VMware Licensing Glossary).

VMware Tanzu Platform includes the following components:

- VMware Tanzu Cloud Foundry Application Services and Kubernetes Application Services: sitting at the core of the VMware Tanzu Platform, the app services provide all the platform and application operations / primitives with the choice of a powerful application runtime on either Cloud Foundry or Kubernetes.
- VMware Tanzu Application Catalog: hardened catalog of OSS components
- VMware Tanzu Data Services: a set of data services managed by the platform for developers, supported with hardened, validated configurations. Included data services are:
 - VMware Tanzu RabbitMQ
 - VMware Tanzu Postgres
 - VMware Tanzu for MySQL
 - VMware Tanzu for Redis
- VMware Tanzu Spring Enterprise: long term support for the Java Spring framework, commercial components and Spring app discovery and operations
- VMware Tanzu Salt Enterprise: commercial capabilities for the Salt configuration management and security capability
- VMware Tanzu Kubernetes Grid Integrated (TKGi): Kubernetes-based runtime

1. DEFINITIONS.

All terms defined in the VMware Licensing Glossary located at <http://www.broadcom.com/company/legal/licensing> apply to this SPD unless specified herein.

“**App Instance**” is an application instance of an application running on VMware Tanzu Cloud Foundry Application Service. Within Tanzu Cloud Foundry Application Service the Broadcom-supplied control plane components, Broadcom-supplied network components, and Broadcom-supplied Service Brokers do not count as App Instances.

“**Core**” means a unit of measure that is defined based on the environment in which the Broadcom Offering operates: (1) in a physical computing environment, a Core is a single physical computational unit of a physical CPU for executing machine instructions; (2) in a virtualized or hypervisor (VM) computing environment, a Core is a single physical computational unit of a physical CPU for executing machine instructions which may be presented as one or more virtualized CPUs (vCPUs) and/or (3) in a public cloud computing environment, a Core is defined as a single physical computational unit of a physical CPU for executing machine instructions, which may be presented as one or more virtualized CPUs (vCPUs), but may be named differently by the public cloud vendors (e.g., Amazon Web Services uses the term “vCPU”, Microsoft Azure uses the term “Core” or “vCPU”, and Google Cloud Platform uses the term “Virtual CPU”). In cases where Hyperthreading is not enabled, one (1) vCPU is recognized as one Core. In cases where Hyperthreading is enabled, two (2) vCPUs are recognized as one Core.

“**Tanzu Platform Units**” are platform consumption units that are convertible to units of VMware Tanzu Platform components, including cores or App Instances.

2. USE RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.

The Software is licensed as Subscription Software. Customer may use the Software and Support solely during the Subscription term. Customer must pay for all the Software Customer uses.

At the end of the Subscription term, Customer may have the option to renew the Subscription licenses. If Customer does not renew, the Subscription licenses shall expire at the end of the Subscription term. Upon expiration or termination of Customer's licenses to the Software, Customer must cease use of the Software, Documentation and Support and certify cessation of use to VMware.

VMware may, at its discretion, retire Software and/or Support from time to time.
